



A Level Revision Course for MFL Students

How to be an Outstanding A Level Linguist

A revision course for AS and A2 students

This day course is designed for all students in Years 12 & 13 taking the new MFL A Level Exams in French, Spanish & German. It will focus on the exams themselves as well as the skills needed to maximise potential and earn every mark come the big day. The sessions will not simply be lectures from experts – there will be plenty of opportunities to practise the suggested ideas, ask questions and hopefully have some fun.

Course Outline:

- 9.30 - 10.00 Coffee and registration
- 10.00 - 11.00 **Writing – what do I need to do & how do I do it?**
A look at the details of the exams followed by practical ideas to meet the Examiners' demands and then practical work for all delegates. This will cover both the AS writing & the new A2 Culture paper.
- 11.00 - 11.15 Coffee
- 11.15 - 12.00 **Grammar – hate it, loathe it, can't do it!**
A look at both the general principles of grammar required for A Level and the type of exercise used to test it, both overt and discreet
- 12.00 - 1.00 Lunch
- 1.00 - 1.45 **Reading & listening**
Two very important skills which are perhaps not always taught in as much detail as their value in marks might demand. This session will cover both theory and practice and finish by testing delegates.
- 1.45 - 2.45 **The Oral – even more stressful than your driving test – or is it?**
The worst twenty minutes of your life? It may seem so, but this lively session will seek to lower the stress levels and offer very practical and instantly usable methods to ensure that every last mark is wrung from those horrible people awarding marks. Be warned, you will be expected to speak!
- 2.45 - 3.00 **Plenary & Close**
